Assistant Unit Leader

Purpose: Responsible for supporting the Unit Leader and stepping in in their absence *in addition to counselor responsibilities.*

Qualifications:

- 1. Minimum 19 years of age.
- 2. Two years experience in organized camping.
- 3. Demonstrated ability to lead and supervise adults and children.
- 4. Good communication skills.
- 5. Interest, knowledge, and skill in a variety of camp program fields.
- 6. Familiarity with diabetes management is preferred. (training provided)

Responsible To: Camp Director, Assistant Director, and Director of Programs

Duties and Responsibilities:

- 1. Step in as Acting Unit Leader when the counterpart is off of camp property or unavailable to staff (i.e. sick, injured, in meetings, on trips, etc.)
- 2. Relay notes to the Unit Leader of any issues that arise, problems solved, duties completed, etc. when they return from their time away.
- 3. Attend all Senior Staff meetings.
- 4. Act as role model to fellow counselors in the unit.
- 5. All other duties as assigned.

Essential Functions:

- Ability to supervise staff.
- Ability to observe campers and staff and manage problems in the Unit.
- Ability to provide leadership and be a good role model.
- Ability to understand the entire operation of the camp.
- Ability to assess the needs within the Unit and escalate problems as needed.
- Ability to articulate daily successes and challenges for each cabin in the Unit.
- Available to work all summer camp sessions.
