- 4. Have good communication skills and work well with children, adults and groups.
- 5. Interest, knowledge, and skill in a variety of camp program fields.
- 6. Familiarity with diabetes management preferred. (training provided)

Responsible To: Camp Director, Assistant Director, and Director of Programs

## **Duties and Responsibilities:**

- 1. Provides leadership and guidance to a cabin group of LITs.
- 2. Works with other LIT Directors to ensure a successful program.
- 3. Acts as a role model to campers, LITs, and peers with regard to diabetes and nutrition management.
- 4. Facilitates and participates in staff training week.
- 5. Enforces safety and health regulations. Reports hazards to Camp Director and/or Health Center Director.
- 6. Maintains cabin and camp as a safe and clean environment.
- 7. Guides the LITs in group, unit, and program activities.
- 8. Evaluates LITs' participation in program.
- 9. Assists with program activities and other activities in the unit, working closely with the Unit Leader, Program Director, and other Senior Staff.
- 10. Responsible for monitoring during free time.
- 11. Supervises cabin during meal times and snack times.
- 12. Assists LITs with diabetes management as required, as outlined by the Health Center Director, and in compliance with the Medical Guidelines.
- 13. Attends staff meetings and contributes information, ideas, and evaluations.
- 14. Cleans and prepares camp and cabins for incoming LITs for each camp session.
- 15. Prepares LIT Manual prior to LIT arrival.
- 16. Agrees and abides by the terms outlined in the Healthy Living Contract.
- 17. Abides by all Camp Personnel Policies.
- 18. Learn and abide by Camp Nejeda's Anti-Bullying Policy to ensure that bullying is not permitted.
- 19. Participates in camp trips as assigned.
- 20. Assists Program Director in taking pictures for Bunk1.
- 21. Greets parents and campers on opening and closing day of each session with warmth and enthusiasm.
- 22. Responsible for creating an inclusive environment for all campers and staff.
- 23. Performs OD as assigned.
- 24. Assigns LITs to counselor mentors.
- 25. Leads LITs in planning theme weekend and supervises all aspects of the program.
- 26. Works with Camp Director to plan and implement all LIT trips, including scheduling, packing and unpacking vehicles.

- 27. Performs the duties of S.O.D., including evening on-duty, bell ringing, announcements, supervision of flag raising and lowering, singing and announcements after meals and monitoring pavilion.
- 28. Attends daily senior staff meetings.
- 29. Becomes familiar with and helps to maintain ACA and NJ Department of Health standards.
- 30. Works in cooperation with Executive Director and Health Center staff, Dietitian, Nurses, Culinary Director, Director of Programs, and Maintenance Director.
- 31. Work with LITs to identify unique skills and talents that can translate into program activities.
- 32. Attends weekly staff meetings and contributes information, ideas, and evaluation.
- 33. Takes initiative in recognizing needs of campers, counselors, and other Senior Staff and assisting appropriately.
- 34. All other duties as assigned.

- Ability to provide leadership.

- Ability to provide basic diabetes care and respond appropriately to emergencies.
- Ability to monitor and supervise cabin group throughout the day in all areas of camp.
